

## Flu Vaccine Clinics are now available

**Influenza season is here** and vaccination is now available. We are running clinics to make the process fast and simple. Please call reception to book into a clinic or make an appointment with your doctor and have it as part of your consultation. All flu vaccine clinics are bulk-billed but we are unable to provide any other service in the clinic - just a fast jab and go!

**Free influenza vaccine is available** for the following groups who are at higher risk of complications from influenza:

- all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people aged 6 months and over
- all children aged 6 months to less than 5 years of age
- all individuals aged 5 years and over with medical conditions that put them at higher risk (e.g. heart and lung disease, neurological conditions, diabetes)
- people who are immunocompromised due to disease or treatment (e.g. malignancy, transplantation and/or chronic steroid use)
- pregnant women (influenza vaccine can be given at any stage of pregnancy)
- people aged 65 years and over (a vaccine that is specifically designed to produce a higher immune response is available for this group).

If you do not qualify for a free vaccination the cost is \$17 per vaccine.

# **CLINICAL TIP OF THE MONTH**

### Avoid putting anything smaller than your elbow in your ear!

- Ears are self cleaning (they have small hairs that beat rythically and move the wax out) so you only need to remove wax from your outer ear with a face washer or tissue.
- Do not use cotton buds or bobby pins in your ears as these can push the wax further in your ear and cause it to become impacted.
- This can also result in ear infections from trauma to the external ear canal.
