# Tip CLINICAL Month

- Wounds should be kept covered and moist to promote healing. Do not leave a wound open to air until it has healed.
- After gently cleaning a simple wound cover it with a non-adherent dressing, keep it dry and change the dressing regularly.
- For more complicated wounds please seek medical attention.
